Courses and Programmes

St John's

Alpha: An opportunity to explore the meaning of life in an informal, fun and friendly environment. The Alpha Course is a series of talks run every term for 10 weeks.

The Marriage Course: To help couples invest in their relationship and build a strong marriage, run once or twice a year for 7 weeks.

The Marriage Preparation Course: To help engaged couples, or those exploring the possibility of marriage, build strong foundations for their future together, run twice a year for 5 weeks.

The Recovery Course: For those struggling with addictions to drugs, alcohol, porn, sex, gambling, self-harming and other compulsive behaviours. Its purpose is to help individuals on a path to freedom from the grip of an addiction, run once a year.
